

How to lay a path

using Blue Circle Cement

Materials and Tools

- Blue Circle Multi-Purpose Concrete
- Gravel or hardcore
- Wooden boards
- Wooden stakes
- Mallet
- String
- Spirit level
- Shovel
- Wheelbarrow
- Tamper
- Plastic sheeting
- Safety gear

Step by step guide

- 1. Plan and Design** - Measure and mark the path area, planning the layout and design of the path.



- 2. Prepare the Area** - Dig out the marked path area to a depth of about 6 inches to allow for a hardcore foundation layer and the concrete path upper layer.



- 3. Construct formwork** - Use wooden boards to create shuttering to contain the mixed concrete, ensuring it is level.



- 4. Create a solid foundation** - Pour a layer of hardcore or gravel into the excavated area. Level and compact the gravel foundation layer using the tamper.



- 5. Mixing and Laying the Concrete** – Following the instructions on the bag, mix the ready-to-use Blue Circle Multi-Purpose Concrete. Place the mixed concrete onto the gravel foundation, spreading it evenly with a shovel and level with a straight edge.



Clean your tools promptly after finishing to prevent any material from hardening on them.

- 6. Curing the Path** – Protect the concrete path from rain and frost and allow to cure according to the manufacturer's recommendations before use.
