

## Legal Notice & Terms

# Rock Stars: Mountsorrel Quarry Schools Competition

By entering the Rock Stars: Mountsorrel Quarry Schools Competition ("the Competition"), participants, their parents or legal guardians agree to the following terms:

### 1. Eligibility

The Rock Stars: Mountsorrel Quarry Schools Competition is open to children aged 5-11 who attend primary schools in Mountsorrel, Quorn, and the surrounding local area. This includes nearby villages such as Barrow upon Soar, Rothley, Swithland, and Woodhouse Eaves.

While the competition is designed to be locally focused, entries are accepted from children within Leicestershire from outside this core area.

Entries must be submitted by a parent or legal guardian on behalf of the pupil. Only one entry per child is permitted.

### 2. Entry Submission

Entries must be submitted digitally via the official Mountsorrel Quarry Schools Competition webpage by the stated closing date. Entries must adhere to the specified format. All entries must be the pupil's original work.

### 3. Competition administration

This competition is being organised and administered on behalf of Tarmac by EQ Communications, a specialist community engagement and communications agency. EQ Communications is responsible for the delivery of competition materials, managing entries, liaising with schools and judges, and producing related publicity content.

### 4. Judging & Prizes

Entries will be judged by an independent panel comprised of representatives from local community organisations and Tarmac Mountsorrel Quarry. Judging will be conducted in good faith, based on creativity, relevance to the theme, effort, and impact. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Should a consensus not be reached, Tarmac will have the casting vote. Depending on the number of entries, an initial round of judging may take place by the competition organisers to reduce the time requirement of the judging panel. These entries will be judged according to the same criteria.

- 1st Prize: Four tickets to a day at the Silverstone Festival 2025 and a Tarmac goody bag, plus VIP visit to Mountsorrel Quarry including up to 3 family guests (see below).
- 7 Runners-up: VIP group visit to Mountsorrel Quarry (including up to 3 family guests) and Tarmac merchandise.

### 5. Accuracy and Discretion

EQ Communications will take reasonable care in the administration and judging process but reserves the right to make adjustments in the event of technical errors, late entries, or unforeseen circumstances, in consultation with Tarmac.

### 6. Use of Images and Entries

By submitting an entry, parents/guardians grant Tarmac and its affiliates the right to use the entry and any accompanying media (e.g., photos of the artwork, child, or family at the Quarry) for promotional purposes including but not limited to websites, social media, press releases, and printed displays. Full names of children will not be published without prior written consent.

Winning entries may be displayed at local events, including Mountsorrel Revival, and at the Quarry.

### 7. Safeguarding & Supervision

All site visits (e.g., Quarry tour) will take place in non-operational areas and will be supervised by Tarmac representatives, in accordance with Tarmac's health and safety and safeguarding policies.

Parents/guardians must accompany children during all site visits and are responsible for travel to and from the Quarry.

### 8. Prizes

Prizes are non-transferable and non-exchangeable. In the unlikely event the Silverstone Festival is cancelled or rescheduled, an equivalent alternative prize will be offered at Tarmac's discretion.

### 9. Liability

Neither Tarmac nor EQ Communications accept responsibility for entries lost, delayed or submitted incorrectly. Neither party shall be held liable for any loss, injury, damage, or delay resulting from participation in the competition, attendance at prize events, or use of prize items, except where required by law. All reasonable efforts will be made to ensure safe and fair administration of the competition.

### 10. Data processing and protection

Personal data collected as part of this competition will be handled in accordance with UK data protection laws and Tarmac's/EQ Communication's privacy policy and will only be used for the purposes of administering the competition. EQ Communications may store or handle data temporarily on behalf of Tarmac in line with applicable data protection laws and will not share data with any third party without consent and will be securely deleted after the competition concludes.
