Waymarked walks

Follow the waymarks shown to enjoy these walks

Oak Trail

APPROX 2KM

Start - Panshanger Lane Car Park

A 2km walk to the famous Panshanger Great Oak, one of the largest maiden oaks in the country.



Dragonfly Trail

APPROX 3KM

Start - Thieves Lane Car Park

A 3km walk around the lakes and river that make the park a British Dragonfly Society Hotspot.



Repton Trail

APPROX 4KM

Start - Panshanger Lane Car Park

A 4km walk where you will enjoy the key vistas of the park's Humphrey Repton designed landscape.



Ancient Tree Trail

APPROX 6.5KM

Start - Thieves Lane Car Park or Panshanger Lane Car Park

A longer 6.5km walk taking in the gnarled trunks of the park's internationally significant ancient trees.

Your Visit

Panshanger Park is a very special place, please help our team keep it that way by following these simple rules;

- Keep to the permissive paths
- Take all litter home with you
- Do not swim in the lakes or river
- Keep dogs under close control and out of the river and lakes to avoid disturbance to wildlife
- Keep dogs on leads around livestock
- Pick up after your dog
