Phase 1 Operations:

- Initial soil strip material to be used to create additional Air Pressure Attenuation Bund / Landform. Other soils to be placed within temporary storage to the south east of the Site.
- A formal section of public access is to be established, linking into exiting rights of way to the north and east of the plant site.
- Overburden i.e. material overlying the in-situ rock, will be removed from the Phase 1 area and placed with the existing quarry tip and unprocessable material, within the previously extracted north western area of the quarry.
- The Phase 1 extension will be available for progressive extraction and the development of quarry internal ramps / access.
- Rock will be transported to the existing plant site by dump trucks, to be processed, temporarily stocked and transported from the quarry by HGV to point of sale.
- A long-term quarry land area landscape and habitat management plan will continue to operate to ensure the establishment of land uses e.g. species rich grassland, in accordance with the proposed Concept Restoration Scheme as illustrated on Drawing No. KD.RVL.1.D.013.
