

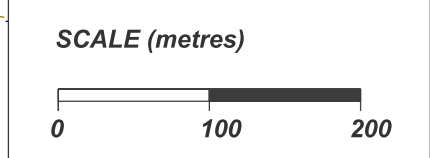

**Phase 2 Operations:**

- Soils and overburden will continue to be progressive stripped, with soils being placed into temporary storage to the south in bunds to be grass seeded and maintained. Overburden will be placed within the existing quarry void, with the landform being design to facilitate the restoration / reinstatement of the lost hillside of Dalmahoy Hill. The upper slopes are to be permanently restored and managed.
- The southern overburden slope will be grass seeded and maintained.
- Phase 2 extension extraction will continue southwards to open up the quarry void to its full extents, with subsequent extraction being deepening only.
- Rock will be transported to the existing plant site by dump trucks, to be processed, temporarily stocked and transported from the quarry by HGV to point of sale.
- A long-term quarry land area landscape and habitat management plan will continue to operate to ensure the establishment of land uses e.g. species rich grassland, in accordance with the proposed Concept Restoration Scheme as illustrated on Drawing No. KD.RVL.1.D.013.
