

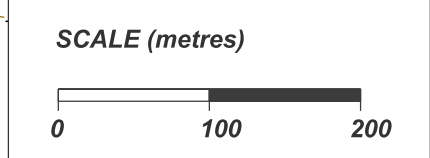

Phase 3 Operations:

- Extraction will continue during Phase 3, via the deepening of the previously extracted void to a base level of 130.0mAOD.
- Rock will be transported to the existing plant site by dump trucks, to be processed, temporarily stocked and transported from the quarry by HGV to point of sale.
- A long-term quarry land area landscape and habitat management plan will continue to operate to ensure the establishment of land uses e.g. species rich grassland, in accordance with the proposed Concept Restoration Scheme as illustrated on Drawing No. KD.RVL.1.D.013.
