The standard specifies requirements for an occupational health and safety management system (OH&S), and gives guidance for its use, to enable organisations to provide safe and healthy workplaces by preventing work-related injury and ill health, as well as by proactively improving its OH&S performance

To achieve this certification, BSI conducted over 50 site audits across Materials and BP sites as well as a number conducted by the Quality and Assurance team. All this demonstrates Tarmac's commitment to health, safety and welfare of our employees and the importance of 'Work Safe, Home Safe'.
